

Above and Beyond

The Missouri Alliance for Life is a statewide organization dedicated to assisting Life agencies in Missouri. The AFL assists 71 affiliates in 104 locations which includes Pregnancy Help Centers, Maternity Homes, Adoption Agencies, and post-abortion recovery for men and women. AFL helps save and change lives. AFL provides for these affiliates training for boards, staff, and volunteers; development courses for clients; counseling, resources, and support during pregnancy and post-delivery. AFL also networks with our state legislators. The AFL accomplishes together what could never be done apart. Pastor Dar Karsten has served as AFL chairman for 9 years.

Each year at the AFL conference, a special award is given to a Pregnancy Center director and to a staff member. This year, the 2024 staff member Above and Beyond Servant Staff award was presented to Angie Geiler at the November AFL conference.

Angie is an RN who does ultrasounds on clients at the MyLife Medical and Resource Center in High Ridge. Clients who may have come to MyLife abortion-minded, often change their minds and choose life after they see their baby's heartbeat on the monitor. Here is just some of what her director expressed that was read prior to her receiving this award.

"Her servant heart goes above and beyond. When Angie hears of a need, she is all over it! Angie has a huge heart. She takes steps to make sure clients are taken care of and have all they need, sometimes even purchasing items herself; she has a wonderful work ethic... She takes her job seriously. Angie is always on time, and goes the extra mile to be here early or stay





